Sunset namedRecognized School by T.E.A.

In May 2009, Sunset High School was named a "Recognized School" by the Texas Education Agency for it's Preliminary TAKS scores while for 2007-2008 they were rated as acceptable. By receiving this rating Sunset became one of only three comprehensive high schools in DISD to achieve this designation. One of the key changes was altering teacher schedules so they would get a "collaborative" period which in turn allowed more work time with students.

Since 2006, the reading and language arts TAKS scores improved from 77 to 82 percent. This is a big improvement for Sunset because in order to be named a "Recognized School", it must have at least 75 percent of it's students pass the TAKS test in all four academic areas. Congratulations to the staff and students for this outstanding recognition.
