Judge Brown Fite

Judge Brown Fite was an Oak Cliff Legend in the field of Real Estate and was a fourth generation Texan, born and raised in Dallas County. He attended Rosemont Elementary and helped out with family chores that included chopping and picking cotton. But in 1937, he decided that it was easier and more fun to sell the land than to work it. Thus began a long and very successful career in real estate.

When World War II broke out, he proudly joined in December 1942 and served his country as a counter intelligence agent with the U.S. Army until January 1946. He would receive the Bronze Star and Purple Heart.

Judge married Modenia "Dene" Earle Long and together they raised 4 children, all graduates of Sunset High School.

Judge Fite served on committees organizations that and included Director of the Greater Dallas Board of Realtors, Director of TAR for 8 terms, Director of NAR and many others.

Judge and Dene Fite were staunch supporters of Oak Cliff and Sunset High School. Judge was a mentor, teacher and lecturer to many real estate agents. Dene was a "mother" and friend to anyone who knew her.

Judge passed the baton to his children, Jim and Jan, who have continued the Fite real estate legacy under the well known Century 21 Judge Fite Company.

It was a great sorrow when Judge Brown Fite left us on February 2, 2003 but his legacy will continue. Dene passed away on October 5, 2010.






