We know that there are Grants out there. We just don't have the people power to make the necessary applications.



Donations go to fund yearly Grants for the Faculty and Students of Sunset. The teachers, coaches & counselors submit Grant Requests at the beginning of the school year. The maximum allowed per request is \$500. The Board of Directors of the Association does reserve the right to award more than the \$500 if it is believed to be a worthwhile cause.

A few years ago, the Association voted to up this limit for one request in order to replace the Mascot Uniform. It was in such bad repair that the cleaners would not even take it in for cleaning!

The Board then reviews each application and depending upon the funds available then grants the requests. (DISD has really cut back on funds throughout the years and many of the staff buy items personally for their needs. We hope to eliminate this as much as possible.)

Then comes the work! Barbara Flint, our President, does the ordering of the items requested. This year a couple of the other Board members assisted. DISD is limited to what vendors can be used. The Board of the Association is not limited, and we can usually get more for our money by smart shopping. The items are then delivered to the requesters at the school.
